NEW DAYLIGHT

New Daylight is produced by the Bible Reading Fellowship and provides four months of daily Bible readings and comment, using a regular team of contributors drawn from a range of church backgrounds. It is ideal for anybody wanting an accessible yet stimulating aid to spending time with God each day, deepening their faith and their knowledge of Scripture.

Rooted in the rhythms of the Christian year, New Daylight is published in January, May and September and covers a varied selection of Old and New Testament, biblical themes, characters and seasonal readings. Each day offers a short Bible passage (text included), thought-provoking comment and a prayer or point for reflection.

It has been some time since Bible Reading notes have been available and an order with the Christian Bookshop in Chippenham will be placed shortly for the next series. 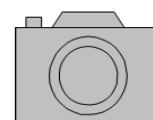
