19 October 2007

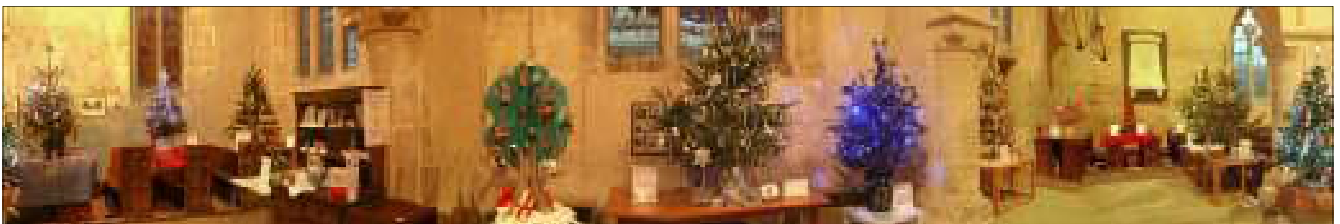
**The humourist Miles Kington talked to us about
